- Learn effective techniques for functional positioning and development activities for pediatric patients.
- Understand the necessary adjustments to mechanical ventilator support and how to safely monitor mechanical ventilation during early mobilization.
- Explore the equipment and technology available to facilitate early mobilization and improve patient care.
- Grasp the use of ultrasound as a tool for assessing and monitoring muscular function in pediatric patients.
- Provide participants with the opportunity to practice and apply learned concepts through practical exercises and clinical cases.

These objectives will help participants understand the relevance of bundles for a broader approach to patient care and acquire a comprehensive understanding of the skills necessary to effectively apply these approaches in the clinical care of pediatric patients.
