Dr Mohammod Jobayer Chisti has been working in icddr,b since March`1998. He is a Senior Scientist and Head of the Emergency Department in icddr,b.

He has a particular interest in low cost innovative work and their scale up in resource limited settings in reducing under-five childhood mortality especially from pneumonia, PARDS, sepsis, diarrhea, and malnutrition.
