- Initiate those involved in acquiring the necessary skills for the understanding, performance and mastery of Transcranial Doppler, duplex and optic nerve sheath, Non-invasive techniques, performed at the patient's bedside, which allows the assessment of cerebral hemodynamics, useful in all those pathologies that can affect cerebral perfusion (intracranial hypertension, traumatic brain injury, CNS infections, stroke, subarachnoid hemorrhage, etc.)
